Angela Cummine outlines Thomas Piketty in three different parts of Citizen's Wealth. In her Introduction, Piketty observes that inequality is a far greater domestic issue than an international one. In the second chapter, Cummine outlines Piketty's correlation between private and public wealth in developed and developing economies, using the United Nations System of National Accounts to create a comprehensive historical dataset for the period 1970 to 2010. Finally, Cummine discusses Piketty's theories on financial and non-financial assets as two main forms of national wealth.
